While the program is

being phased in by ages, all persons operating any type of motorized (10 hp or more) vessel, will eventually have to have taken and passed a certified safe boating class. We want you to have an opportunity to take the class at a convenient location, so we will have the class in the clubhouse!!! It is an 8-hour, certified class, and upon passing the class, you will be given your certificate of completion. Our "famous" Fred Olverson will be providing lunch for all participants. The cost of the class....there is no charge!!! Signup sheet will be on the bulletin board, or contact the Marina Office.

RECIPE CORNER



Tender Tomato Chicken

6 Tablespoons olive oil 6 skinless boneless chicken breast halves 2 Tablespoons pepper 1/4 cup onion powder (or more)

- 2 28 ounce cans chopped stewed tomatoes (reserving 1/2 the liquid)
- 2 14 ounce cans chicken broth
- 20 ounces frozen mixed vegetables

1/2 cup water

Heat oil in skillet over medium heat; season chicken on both sides with pepper and onion powder. Cook chicken 2 minutes on each side, until brown. Pour tomatoes and reserved liquid over chicken. Add broth. Cover skillet and continue cooking 15 minutes on each side or until chicken juices run clear. While chicken is cooking, place frozen vegetables and water in a pot; scoop about 3/4 cup liquid from the skillet and mix into pot. Bring to a boil and cook 5 minutes. Drain. Arrange chicken breast over the vegetables and drizzle with liquid from skillet to serve. Serves 6 We like this over rice.
