MESSAGE FROM OUR VICE COMMODORE - STEVE THOMPSON



TOMATO BASIL SALAD

INGREDIENTS

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons cider vinegar
- 2 teaspoons chopped fresh basil or 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 3 cups cooked rice, cooled
- 2 medium tomatoes, chopped
- 1 medium cucumber, seeded and chopped
- 1 small red onion, chopped

DIRECTIONS

In a small bowl, whisk together oil, vinegar, basil, salt and pepper. Add rice, tomatoes, cucumber and onion; toss. Serve chilled. Yield: 6 servings.

FISHERMANS CORNER

Striped Bass (Rockfish) Spring Season Summer/Fall Season

Season Open: April 20 through May 15 May 16 through December 31

Open Area: Below Harry W. Nice Bridge (Rt. 301) Below Woodrow Wilson Bridge (I-95)

Minimum Size Limit: 28" 18" with only 1 over 28"

Possession Limit: 1 per person 2 per person
Bait Restrictions: No live eel. No more than 2 hooks None

Special Restriction: When Fishing for Striped Bass During the Closed Season – Barbless Hooks are Required

2013 Junior Angler Fishing Tournament At Olverson's August 24, 2013 Sign Up Sheet Is In The Clubhouse

Again this year, since some of our junior anglers are not so "junior" anymore, we have a teen division. All teens, ages 13 through 19, are eligible to participate.

Rules for the **Junior Division** remain the same:

- 1. All children 12 and under are eligible to participate
- 2. ALL Anglers <u>must</u> be pre-registered by August 17—no exceptions please
- 3. Final weigh-in of fish at 2:00 PM on A Dock
- 4. Fishing is allowed from the dock or a boat, angler's choice. All species of fish will be considered
- 5. No restrictions on the body of water that is fished, but anglers must depart from Olversons Marina at 9:00 AM and return by 2:00 PM for weigh-in
- 6. Awards to the Junior Anglers will be presented at the Function that evening

Rules for the **Teen Division** are as follows:

- 1. All children 13 through 19 are eligible to participate
- 2. All Anglers *must* be pre-registered by August 17---no exceptions, please
- 3. Final weigh-in of fish at 2:00 PM on A Dock
- 4. Fishing is allowed from the dock or a boat, angler's choice. All species of fish will be considered
- 5. No restrictions on the body of water that is fished, but anglers must depart Olverson's Marina at 9:00 AM and return by 2:00 AM for weigh-in
- 6. Awards to the Teen Anglers will be presented at the Function that evening
