Sausage and scrambled egg muffins

1 pound sausage
1/4 cup chopped onion
6 eggs
shredded cheese
8 refrigerated rolls

Brown sausage with onion, drain. Press rolls into bottom of large muffins pan. Put in cooked sausage mixture. Mix eggs with salt and pepper, pour on top of sausage then sprinkle with cheese. Bake 20-25 minutes at 350* or until eggs are firm.
