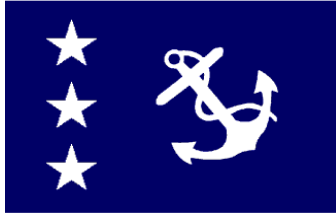

It's time to show your pride in your country, your flag, and the men and women that serve and protect it.

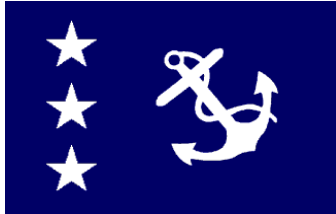

The Virginia Boating Law requires that effective July 1, 2014, all persons 45 years or under are required to complete a certified Safe Boating Education Course and must carry a certification card while operating a PWC or other motorized vessel with 10HP or more.

Good News!!! On Saturday, June 28, 2014, Lodge Creek Yacht Club and Olverson's Marina will be sponsoring the certified BOAT VIRGINIA class for FREE!!! Olverson's Marina is providing lunch for participants of this all day class!

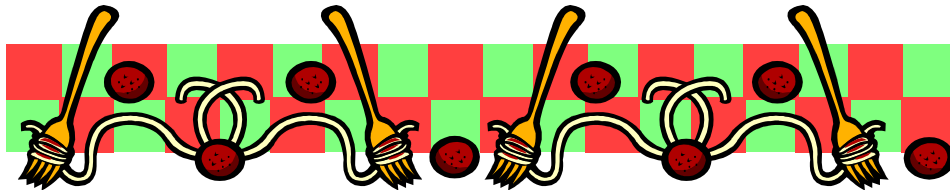
MESSAGE FROM OUR B-DOCK DIRECTOR: RICH VERDILLO

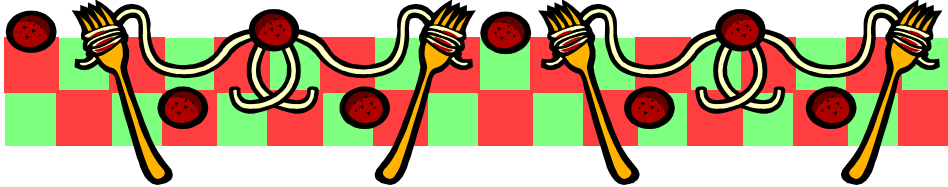
