# **RECIPE CORNER**



### **Cruisin' Crab Dip**

(8-ounce) packages cream cheese, softenedClick to see savings

1 (4.5-ounce) can chopped green chiles, drained Click to see savings

1 cup seeded and chopped tomatoesClick to see savings

1 small clove garlic, minced

1/4 to 1/2 cup whipping cream

2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice Click to see savings

1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce

1 teaspoon hot sauce

1/4 teaspoon ground red pepper

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper Click to see savings

1 pound fresh jumbo lump crabmeat, drained

Garnish: chopped fresh parsley

Prep:

Combine first 11 ingredients in a large nonstick skillet; place over low heat, and cook, stirring constantly, until mixture is smooth and bubbly. Gently fold in crabmeat. Spoon into serving bowl, and garnish, if desired. Serve with French bread slices toasted with Casino Butter.
