Let's make our last function this month the best attendance ever! Please come out and help elect next year's bridge, get Change of Watch and other information as well as a great dinner and camaraderie!

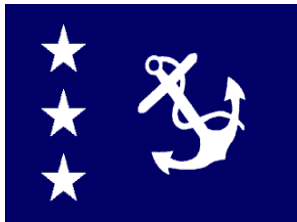

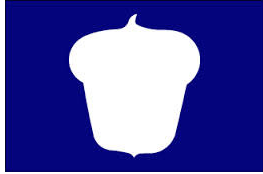
