At the last Bridge Meeting we agreed to revise the LCYC By Laws with this section to be in the Membership Status as number 6 regarding Resignation, Suspension, Expulsion and Leave of Absence, which was never put in the By Laws.

We have to give the membership proper notice in writing for any proposed revisions made to the By Laws. The change will be made within 30 days if there are no objections. Below is our proposed revision:

Section 6 - Resignation, Suspension, Expulsion and Leave of Absence:

- It is LCYC's policy that no board member, member, or guest be subjected to discrimination or harassment of any kind, including unruly behavior, discrimination or harassment forbidden by law, or involving race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, height, weight, marital status, veteran status, or disability. LCYC will take strong disciplinary steps, up to and including termination of membership, against any board member, member, or guest whom it determines engages in discrimination or harassment.
- (a) Resignations must be in writing, forwarded to the Secretary and shall not relieve the member from paying the annual dues for the current year. No resignation will be accepted until all dues, fines, and charges have been paid and all keys returned.
- **(b)** Leave of Absence may be granted a regular member in good standing upon receipt of a written request for such leave, for a period not to exceed two (2) years except for active military personnel transferred from the area. A majority vote of the members present and voting at any regular or special meetings of the club shall constitute approval.

- (c) If any member shall be charged in writing, addressed to the Board of Directors, by any member, with conduct injurious to the good order or interest of the club, or at variance with the requirements of its by-laws and rules, or if the Board of Directors shall become cognizant of such conduct, the Board of Directors shall thereupon inform the member charged, in writing, and if, upon inquiry, and after giving the person so charged an opportunity to be heard, the Board of Directors shall be satisfied of the truth of the charge, and that the same demands such action, it may proceed to suspend such member for a period of time not exceeding six months, or it may request him to resign; and if he declines, it may expel him. An affirmative vote of at least eight members of the Board of Directors shall be required for expelling or suspending a member.
- (d) At any time within thirty (30) days after the suspension or expulsion of a member, a meeting of the club shall be called, if requested in writing by ten (10) members of the club, addressed to the Secretary, at which meeting an appeal may be taken from the decision of the Board of Directors, and the member may be restored to his position by a vote of three-fourths of the full members present and voting. The expelled member may be present at such meeting.
- **(e)** Any person whose membership has been canceled for cause other than non-payment of dues, reinstatement shall not be effected until such causes are corrected or removed.
- **(f)** The Board of Directors shall have the power to suspend all club privileges of any member who is found guilty of any act of misconduct upon the club premises or any violation of the club rules. The maximum penalties which may be imposed by the Board of Directors are:

<u>First Offense</u> - Thirty (30) day suspension.

<u>Second Offense</u> within one (1) year -- thirty (30) day minimum; sixty (60) day maximum suspension.

<u>Third Offense</u> within one (1) year -- sixty (60) day minimum; ninety (90) day maximum suspension.

<u>Fourth Offense</u> within two (2) years -- Permanent suspension.

BOATERS SAFE BOATING COURSE - Effective July 1, 2019 all Virginia boater must have taken a Certified Boaters Safe Boating Course and have proof of this while boating in Virginia waters while operating any vessel powered by a motor of at least 10 hoursepower. This law makes no distinction of age or experience.

As we start the boating season, we must all renew our commitment for SAFE BOATING.

VESSEL SAFETY CHECKS - The most cautious boaters can sometimes experience unexpected problems on the water. That's why the U.S. Coast Guard recommends that all recreational boaters, including personal watercraft and paddle sport users take advantage of the free Vessel Safety Check Program every year. We have certified Vessel Safety Check Examiners here at Olverson's Marina. Please contact the Marina Office and office personnel will provide you with contact information for retting this free examination. Once you have with contact information for getting this free examination. Once you have completed this free 15-minute examination, you will be given a decal that can proudly be displayed on your vessel. Taking a few minutes to have your vessel checked, just may save you from problems this season!
