RADIO CHECKS

It's a good idea to do a radio check on your VHF radio periodically, but unlike in times past, don't use channel 16 as you will get a little reprimand from the Coast Guard. Instead, Sea Tow has set up an automated radio check service. For our area, Middle Chesapeake Bay, use channel 27. Do your normal radio check, e.g. "This is (*Your Boat Name*) wishing to do a radio check". When you release the transmit button you will hear exactly how your transmission sounded and your request is played back to you. No one will respond to you as this service is fully automatic and plays back exactly what you say. The receiver is located just north of Point Lookout, MD, about 11 Nautical Miles away. You can check your radio every time before you go out. Depending upon your location, there are different channels used. If you are cruising and want to do a radio check, just go to <https://www.seatow.com/service-locator/arc?location=callao%2C+va> and change location to get the correct channel for the area. You can also go to <https://www.seatow.com/tools-and-education/automated-radio-check> to learn more about the system and to watch a You Tube video showing how it works.
