


JUNE 2ND . VA BOATING SAFETY CLASS

This class always fills up quickly, so call the Marina office and reserve your space today. The class is free, and Olverson's provides a complementary lunch.

To operate a motor vessel of 10 hp or more in Virginia waters, you must be able to provide law enforcement proof of completion of an approved boating safety course such as this one.

All materials are included, and it's recommended to bring a pencil w/eraser. There is an exam and a successful passing grade of 70% is required.
